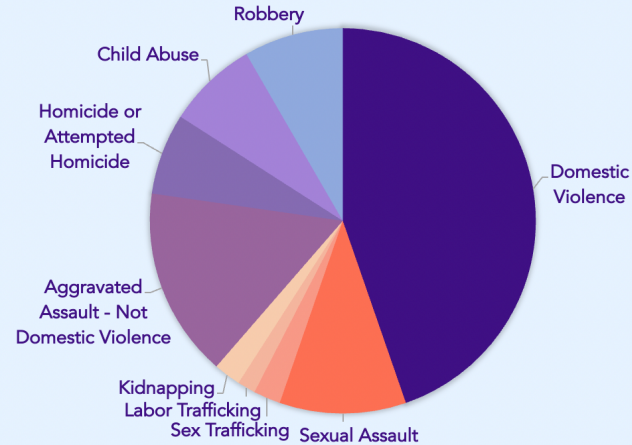


# ADVOCATES FOR IMMIGRANT SURVIVORS 2022 IMPACT SNAPSHOT

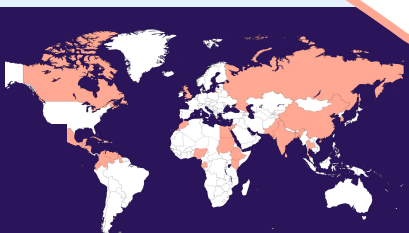
